Spring Festival	February 16 February 17 February 18 February 19 February 20	Friday Saturday Sunday Monday Tuesday	Three days off from February 16 to 18 in accordance with established rules. As two days of Spring Festival fall on Saturday and Sunday, February 19 (Monday) and February 20 (Tuesday) should be the day off to make it up.
Peace Memorial Day	February 28	Wednesday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.
Children's Day	April 4	Wednesday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.
Tomb-sweeping Day	April 5 April 6	Thursday Friday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. April 6 (Friday) adjusts to holiday; March 31 (Saturday) adjusts to work.
Labor Day	May 1	Tuesday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.

Dragon Boat Festival	June 18	Monday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.
Mid-autumn Festival	September 24	Monday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.
National (Double Tenth) Day	October 10	Wednesday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.
Memorial day in honor of Founding of the Republic of China	December 31, 2018 January 1, 2019	Monday Tuesday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. December 31, 2018 (Monday) adjusts to holiday; December 22, 2018 (Saturday) adjusts to work.
